

Why Study with ACBS

The Arab Center for Biblical Studies does more than merely provide biblical training in Arabic. Consider what makes ACBS unique:

Unique Program. ACBS offers a complete program in Arabic to train Arab believers to become faithful disciples of Jesus Christ who can also train others.

Unique Philosophy. Each ACBS course has been especially designed by an expert in his field. These courses emphasize not only *knowledge acquisition*, but also building of character and development of ministry skills. Courses are structured to equip the students to know, to be, and to do what they learn.

Unique Curriculum. While many of the courses have been successfully used around the world for training Christian leaders, others are written specifically for the needs of Arab believers and to help them appreciate their Arab Christian heritage.

Unique Teaching Methods. Students are provided a self-study course book, so that lessons can be completed before meeting with the group. Rather than attending a lecture, students meet regularly with a professional facilitator who leads the group in a stimulating interactive discussion of the material studied. Facilitated sessions can be done (1) in person, or (2) on an online website built for distance education.

Unique Interaction. Students enrolled with ACBS are linked with other Arabic-speaking students across the Arab world to form an online study group, thereby enriching the learning experience, sharing prayer needs, and discussing ministry challenges.

Unique Flexibility. Students do not have to leave their countries, families, or careers, because the course materials and class interaction can take place online or in some cases by Independent Study.
